

How to Apply to AmeriCorps & VISTA Positions at Solid Ground

Online

To apply to any of Solid Ground's national service teams through the national, online application system, go to: www.americorps.gov. Write and save your AmeriCorps application online, and then search and click to apply to:

- **JustServe AmeriCorps (Listing #3124):** Places Members at local criminal justice system programs, middle and high schools, and community- and faith-based organizations to provide prevention and intervention for youth at risk of violence and incarceration, advocacy for domestic violence victim/survivors, re-entry support to people coming out of incarceration, alternatives to incarceration, and mobilize volunteers of all ages and backgrounds to get involved in local anti-violence, social justice work.
- **MLK VISTA Corps (Listing #4383):** Works with community and public agencies throughout King County on housing development and homelessness, welfare to work, low-income access to technology, and family support issues.
- **Washington Reading Corps (Listing #5006-North King County and #5007-South King County):** Places Members in elementary schools in Seattle, Kent, Renton, Highline and Tukwila School Districts to recruit and train community volunteers and provide one-on-one and small group tutoring to increase reading skills.

Paper Application

Please note that **only JustServe AmeriCorps is accepting paper applications**. If you would like to apply to WA Reading Corps, but require assistance completing an online application, you must contact WA Reading Corps staff to schedule an appointment. MLK VISTA applicants must go online to submit their applications.

- 1) Fill out all 7 pages of the paper AmeriCorps application and send it to Solid Ground at:

- 2) Ask **two** community references to send the written AmeriCorps Recommendation to Solid Ground. *AmeriCorps Recommendations can be written by a former employer, teacher, faith leader or other community activist or leader—including AmeriCorps alumni. References should not be written by a family member.*
