JustServe positions include...

- **Prevention & intervention for youth:** Provide leadership development, conflict resolution skills, service learning activities, mentoring and/or support groups for youth at risk of violence and incarceration.
- **Victim advocacy:** Provide crisis intervention, safety planning and advocacy to domestic violence survivors involved in the criminal justice system.
- **Re-entry support:** Provide resource referral, mentoring and support to individuals returning to the community after incarceration.
- **Alternatives to incarceration:** Lead community service activities as alternatives to incarceration for defendants with low-level offenses in Seattle Municipal Court.
- **Volunteer mobilization:** Recruit, train, support and mobilize community members to get involved in violence prevention efforts throughout Seattle/King County.
