SOUTH KING COUNTY:

Algona-Pacific Food Pantry - Driver needed Mondays and Thursdays, 9:00 a.m. - noon to do pick-ups. A truck is provided for you, and no special licenses are needed.

Auburn Community Food Bank - has several volunteer positions available including: receptionist, bagging and sorting of bulk foods and donations, and pick up and delivery using our van. Your efforts **can** make a difference!

Auburn Police Department - Come join Citizens on Patrol (C.O.P) to assist commissioned officers with handicapped parking violations, vacation house checks, graffiti surveillance, park checks, abandoned vehicle reporting and other tasks. Background check and interview required.

Auburn Regional Medical Center - The Auburn Regional Medical Center is looking for a gift shop volunteer manager. The gift shop is run by the ARMC Volunteer Auxiliary. Manager duties would include staffing, buying, stocking, pricing, etc. Volunteer support staff includes an assistant manager, two buyers, two bookkeepers and seven cashiers.

Auburn Senior Activity Center - needs office volunteer substitutes. Must answer multiple phone lines; have basic to intermediate computer skills; and have good customer service skills.

Burien Lunch Program - Volunteer cook needed Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Training provided; Food Handler's Permit required.

Communities in Schools of Federal Way – Be a mentor to a child for 45 minutes per week in a Federal Way School. Mentors serve as an adult friend and positive role model by listening; reinforcing a positive self concept, encouraging and motivating, reinforcing positive social behaviors and helping students think critically and communicate effectively.

Enumclaw Senior Center -

Federal Way City Hall - Lobby Reception - Volunteers are needed to greet and direct visitors to City Hall. One 4-hour shift requested per week. Shifts are 8:30am-12: 30pm and 12:30pm to 4:30pm. Currently need someone for the 8:30am-12: 30 pm shift on Friday mornings, or "subs" to substitute during volunteer vacations.

Federal Way Police Department - volunteer drivers needed. Working in pairs volunteers deliver police vehicles or equipment to appropriate repair sites and arrange for return. Four hours per week, 8:00-noon.

Federal Way Senior Center - Walking & Hiking Group needs additional volunteers to check out and lead future walks/hikes. Walks are held Tuesdays and Mountain Hikes are on Thursdays. Help with advertising 'Computer Classroom' offerings to the public and perform other management tasks. The Computer Classroom needs additional classroom and "at home"

instructors. Also needed are a handy person and a yard work volunteer. Lunch is free with volunteer help!

Kent Senior Center - needs Lunch assistants (Mon. - Fri. 11:00 - 1:00) and Meals on Wheels volunteers ("Substitute" drivers needed on Thursdays), and Singers for Kent Senior Songsters, Sept. to May.

Multi-Service Center - Advocates needed for people living in long term care facilities, on-call movers needed to help with Shelter and Transitional Housing programs, Tutors for Adult Basic Education students, ESL and GED, person skilled in data entry needed, customer service position and people to sort and distribute food to clients needed at the Federal Way food bank. "Friends of MSC" needed to help friend-raise, fund-raise and consciousness-raise.

Pacific/Algona Senior Center - needs a van driver. It is not necessary to have a Commercial license.

Port of Seattle - Assist travelers at Sea-Tac Airport. Saturday and weekday evening coverage needed.

Renton City Hall - Information Desk volunteers greet visitors, answer phone calls and direct citizens to appropriate City departments from the 1st floor lobby of Renton City Hall. Volunteers each work one 4-½ hour per week shift, or serve as a substitute, under the supervision of the City Clerk.

Renton Senior Activity Center - Volunteer Dishwasher: Monday - Friday 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Washing pots and pans from lunch program, and helping other dishwasher person. Volunteer Servers: Monday - Friday 9 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Jobs include setting up dining room and helping to serve/clean up for lunch program.

Valley Medical Center – in Renton.

Way Back Inn - provides housing for homeless families and operates in Kent, Tukwila, South Seattle and Renton. Volunteers can write letters on behalf of the organization (this can be done from home) join the agency's board; assist with maintenance needs (this position can be physically demanding), help with grant writing, or work on the agency newsletter.
