Join Lettuce Link's Community Fruit Tree Harvest team by becoming a Harvest Leader, bringing fresh, local, and organic fruit to those that can use it! Lead 1 to 2 harvests per week and ensure fruit is donated to local food banks and meal programs.



Compensation:

Knowing your neighbors, sharing food with your community and being part of the Good Food Revolution (bringing healthy food to everyone)! Mileage is reimbursed and fresh fruit abounds.

Location:

- Seattle neighborhoods: Ballard, Beacon Hill, Capitol Hill, Central Area, Fremont, Green Lake, NE Seattle, Wallingford, or South Park
- Some computer and phone communication from home

Qualifications:

- Organized
- Able to problem solve and alter plans as needed
- Able to respond to emails in a timely manner
- Reliable transportation

Must be willing to commit to a whole harvest season (avg. 1 harvest/week).

Key Responsibilities:

- Coordinate with homeowners and community volunteers
- Visit trees before harvesting
- Arrange and attend 1 to 2 fruit harvests per week
- Bring equipment for harvests and deliver fruit to food banks

Time Commitment:

3 – 6 hours per week. July – early October. Busiest in August and September. Training/support provided!
