- 6-foot orchard ladders (6)
- Bow rakes (20)
- Buckets for assorted storage
- Building materials for an outdoor classroom roof
- Bulk seeds (*untreated*) in 5-lb increments, or individual seed packets (*2008 or newer: Pak Choi / Gailan / Daikon Radish / Radish / Collard Greens / Beets / Carrots / Kohlrabi / Cucumber / Zucchini / Beans*)
- Children's wheelbarrows (5)
- Classroom-to-garden microscope
- Clipboards, sharpies, scissors, duct tape, etc.
- Compost (*with delivery*)
- Cordless drill
- Digital camera
- Digital produce scale
- Educational soil testing kits (*new please*)
- Felco hand pruners (12)
- First-aid kit (*new please*)
- Flats of plant starts (*cool weather crops; 100 flats*)
- Foot socks to protect fruit from pests (*new please*)
- Fruit pole pickers (12)
- Gardening gloves (*lots needed!*)
- Hand pruners (10)
- Hand trowels (25)
- Hori hori knives
- Hoses, nozzles and sprinklers
- Kid-sized garden tools
- Kid-sized watering cans (10)
- Kneepads (12)
- Lawnmower (*not electric*)
- Mattock (*a small machete used for removing blackberry bramble*)
- Outdoor thermometer
- Plates/cups/silverware for community potlucks/events
- Potting soil (*for starts*)
- Produce storage bins
- Propane stove for community cooking events (*& propane*)
- Remy/floating row cover & stakes
- Rototiller (*& gas cans, ear/eye protection, etc*)
- Seed garlic (50 lbs)
- Shovels (20)
- Spading forks (12)
- Stakes (*wooden*) to label and mark beds
- Storage space (*e.g., garage to hold things like plastic buckets, bags of soil, picking buckets, recycling bins for harvesting fruit, etc.*)
- Threshold to keep rats from entering the shed (3)
- Tomato cages
- Tools: Sets of screwdrivers, sockets, wrenches, handsaws, hammers
- Trellis materials for peas & beans
- Weed whacker
- Wheelbarrows (10)
- White business envelopes (*for repacking seeds; old stationary is fine*)
- Wire brushes to clean tools
